

Cold weather across America is overwhelming homeless shelters

Melinda Bowyer lives in Pennsylvania. She is an Uber driver. Usually, she gets paid to give people rides. She gives free rides to homeless people. She takes them to warm shelters.

Ms. Bowyer is known as the "Uber Queen." She gives her tip money to homeless people she meets.

The winter has been very cold for much of the country. Ms. Bowyer made a decision. She turned off her Uber app. She lets the homeless ride for free. Helping them "is the best feeling in the whole, entire world," she said. "You wouldn't believe the amount of homeless people there are."

People Step Up To Help The Homeless

Many people are stepping up. They help find a warm place for homeless people to stay on very cold nights.

Some homeless shelters are getting crowded. The shelters need food, hats, scarves and gloves. They also need more volunteers.

"It's something I don't understand. We're the richest country in the world, and yet we have to face situations such as these," said Alfred Harrison. He is a reverend in North Carolina. It has been below freezing in his area at night.
